The Award: The North Carolina Peace Prize honors small North Carolina community-based non-profit groups that demonstrate the ideals of the Peace Corps: helping people to help themselves and promoting peace and cross-cultural understanding. The prize is a hand-thrown Seagrove vase, and includes a cash award of \$1,000. The Honorable Sarah E. Parker, Chief Justice of the NC Supreme Court and RPCV Turkey, will make the award presentation.
